

TIMELINE



January 2022 - Project start

During the months of January and February the project consortium were in contact to set up an online kick-off-meeting on March 30. In this first meeting, working guidelines and information on upcoming meetings were established.

June 2022- 1° International meeting - Hungary

First face-to-face meeting of the consortium in Hungary. In this meeting, the partners were able to learn about 5 different good practices in which the training of digital competences was worked with different groups.

September 2022 - 2° International meeting- Spain

Second face-to-face meeting of the project, this time in Spain. The partners were able to enjoy 6 experiences of digital skills training with different groups and entities involved.

March 2023 - 3° International meeting - Estonia

On March 6 and 7, the consortium met again in Estonia to learn about 4 best practices related to the development of digital competencies.

May 2023 - 4° International meeting - Germany

Two months later, the partners worked together again in Germany on the 15th and 16th. During this meeting, they were able to learn about 6 good practices that reflect how digital competencies are worked in this country.

September 2023 - 5° International meeting - Romania

The meeting in Romania was the last face-to-face meeting of the consortium. The partners were able to spend an enjoyable and interesting trip with the presentation of 6 good practices of different entities working on digital skills

October - December 2023

Since the beginning of the project, the consortium has met periodically to advance with the tasks and planning of the face-to-face meetings. In recent months these online meetings have been held on a monthly basis to learn how the different partners were progressing in the tasks established in the project.

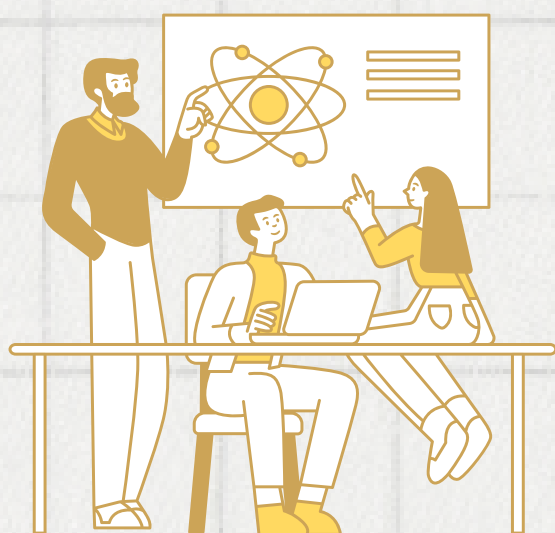
